**GRADE 4-7 EXCURSION  
THEME: CULTURES, TRADITIONS & SOUTH AFRICA'S WILDLIFE**

For this term’s planned outing, the grade 4 - 7 learners will be exploring the different African cultures, traditions and ethnicities together with South Africa’s wildlife and conservation.

To kick off this adventure, learners will be visiting the **Lesedi Cultural Village** to explore the different African cultures, traditions, history and way of life. Learners will thereafter visit the **Lion and Safari Park** where they will get to experience South Africa’s rich wildlife and conservation.

- **Date of Excursion:** 01 June 2023
- **Time:** Learners are expected to arrive at school by no later than 07h30 for departure at 07h45. Learners will arrive back at school for dismissal by 15h30
- **Dress code:** School tracksuits and comfortable sneakers.

The total cost for the excursion will be **R450,00** which includes:

1. Transport to the Lesedi Cultural Village.
2. Entrance fee at Lesedi Cultural Village with the following activities.
  - Learners will be welcomed with traditional song and dance by members of the Lesedi Cultural Village.
  - A multi-visual theatre presentation.
  - A guided tour of the four ethnic villages (Zulu, Xhosa, Sepedi and Sotho)
  - A traditional African Dance Show in the Boma.

After the tour at the Lesedi Cultural Village, learners will have a chance to eat their lunch under the trees, in an African traditional setting, before their departure to the Lion and Safari Park. Although there is a tuckshop, restaurant and curio shops at the Lion Park, learners are encouraged to pack a healthy lunch and other snacks for the excursion.

3. Transport to the Lion and Safari Park.
4. Entrance fee to the Lion and Safari Park where learners will be treated to a 1 ½ hour Mini Safari Tour in open caged vehicles, with trained tour guides to view all the different animal species, i.e white and tawny lions, cheetahs, wild dogs striped and spotted hyenas, antelopes and the gentle giraffes.
